

EWING III GRINDER

The **Ewing III Grinder** is a hand-driven multi-purpose burr mill that can make creamy peanut butter from roasted nuts and fine flour from various grains. It is designed for processing crops to sell in the local market or for family use in rural areas of developing countries. The grinder may be driven with a hand crank, with pedal-power, or with a 0.5–1.5 hp motor. It can be easily disassembled for cleaning.

The **Ewing III** is the newest of several designs that have been optimized over the years by CTI engineers. The Ewing grinder is primarily used in Uganda, Africa where it is manufactured. In addition to small grains and peanuts (groundnuts), Ewing grinders have been used for hulling rice and grinding corn, cassava, dried beans, large seeds, coffee, and other crops.
